Those who are interested in serving the community in this way and want to become a candidate for co-option should obtain an application form from the Clerk.

Any applicant should be over 18, a British subject or citizen of the Republic of Ireland, and either: -

1. A local government elector of the parish, or
2. Has during the previous 12 months occupied as owner or tenant any land or premises in the parish, or
3. His/Her principal or only place of work during that 12 months has been in that area, or
4. Has during the whole of those 12 months resided in the area, or within 3 miles (4.8 kilometres) of it.

Full information on eligibility, the role of the Parish Council and its schedule of meetings may be obtained from the Clerk and/or the Chairman.
